Reminder: Requirements for Attendance at the 2021 I.C.E. Exchange in Nashville, TN as of August 24 Last week we shared with you our updated health and safety policy, which requires all attendees, speakers, exhibitors and support staff, to:

- Be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and provide proof of vaccination <u>or</u> receive a negative COVID-19 test result within three (3) days of Monday, November 15, 2021
- Wear a face mask indoors during the full duration of the I.C.E. Exchange, with the exception of removing face masks while actively eating or drinking
- Follow I.C.E's policies regarding social distancing and personal protection. These policies might evolve over time as new data becomes available. We will keep you informed of any changes to attendee expectations.
- Evaluate your health each morning before committing to joining the day's activities.

Speaker Health and Safety Policies at the Exchange

As I.C.E. researches best practices and CDC guidelines, we are also adapting our health and safety measures to our 2021 Exchange speaker procedures. We currently have the following speaker procedures established:

- There will be 30 minutes between concurrent sessions to allow time for surface sanitation.
- All session handouts will be uploaded in the mobile app instead of printed to limit surface contamination.
- A check-list will be included in each session room with a reminder of health and safety requests
- Social distancing in session rooms, with capacity limitations
- I.C.E. is currently researching further logistics for maintaining health and safety standards in regards to speaker details such as microphone podium use and sanitation, and managing masking when speaking.

I.C.E. Exchange Virtual Attendance

I.C.E. is monitoring the concerns and limitations our attendees, exhibitors, and speakers may have with traveling to the conference. I.C.E. is exploring options for attendees to access the content virtually, and will share information as soon as we can on those details.
